Worldview: The Synod of Dort

Introduction

Worldview matters, and many Christians, sometimes without realizing it, bring poor presuppositions into reading the Bible. The Bible demands absolute obedience and submission to its words, which means obeying its requirements for belief, holiness, and apologetics. When you read the Bible and pit scriptures against one another, you are reading the Bible as an unbeliever. Many Christians claim that the Bible is inerrant, but do not live as though it is. It is the Christian's job to be conformed to the text of Scripture as the foundation for their worldview.

The Synod of Dort

The Synod of Dort took place in the city of Dordrecht in the Netherlands between 1618 and 1619. The Synod was demanded by the States General (Netherlands bicameral government) to dispel rising tensions and the inevitable civil war that would have been fought over the doctrine of Joseph Arminius.
